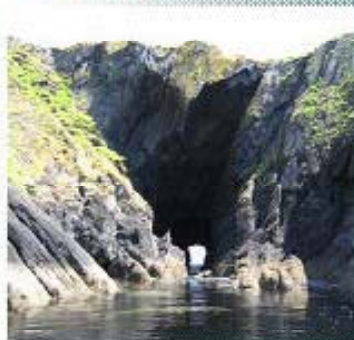


Experience the beauty of West Cork's marine wildlife



The coastal waters of Ireland were declared a whale & dolphin sanctuary in the 1990s and West Cork is the feeding ground for some large species such as the fin, humpback and minke whales.

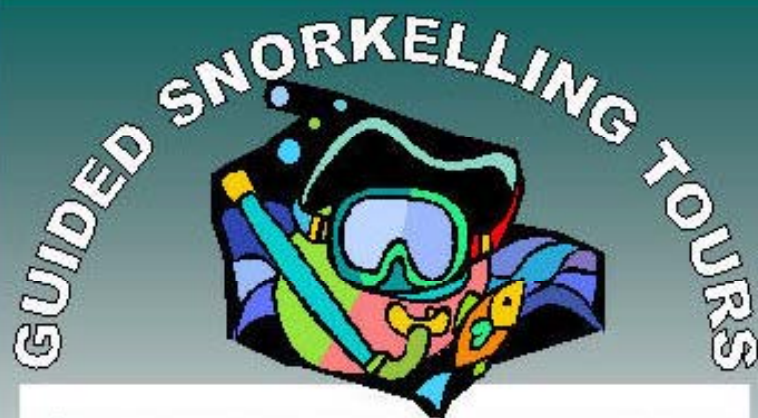
We also have sightings of dolphins, harbour porpoises, sunfish, and leatherback turtles during our boat journeys out and an opportunity to swim with seals.



Sea life at shallow depths that can be enjoyed by snorkellers include sea weeds and kelp, anemones, shellfish, crustaceans and fish such as blennies, dogfish, starfish, squid, pollack, sand eels, pipefish, scorpionfish and different varieties of wrasse.
